



2ND GRADE SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

Students must be prepared to learn each day. Having their supplies ready every day is extremely important so valuable class time is not wasted. All supplies should be labeled with child's name. Supplies need to be replenished throughout the year, as they are consumed, broken or lost. It is a good idea to have some extras stored at home.

- ❑ Bookbag
non-wheeled is preferred by the 2nd grade teachers since students will not be carrying heavy books to and from school.
- ❑ **Light Blue** Parent Communication Folder
this item is only available for purchase at the Kendale Elementary School Store. If you are unable to come in and purchase this item please send \$3 in an envelope with your child's name and LIGHT BLUE Parent Communication Folder and I will send it to the PTA.
- ❑ A zippered pencil pouch (no boxes)
- ❑ 12 sharpened pencils (no mechanical pencils)
- ❑ 1 box of classic Crayola® 24 crayons
- ❑ 1 pack of colored pencils (max 12 count)
- ❑ 1 pair of blunt tip scissors
- ❑ 4 large Elmer's® glue sticks
- ❑ 1 8 oz. bottle of Aleene's® TACKY GLUE®
- ❑ 1 pencil eraser or eraser tops
- ❑ 1 yellow highlighter
- ❑ 1 thin dry erase marker
- ❑ 2 blue ballpoint pens
- ❑ 12" ruler (inches & cm)
- ❑ 7 Regular Wide-Ruled Composition Books (not Primary)
- ❑ Primary Handwriting Tablet (must have red and blue lines)
- ❑ 2 packs of lined loose leaf paper
- ❑ 4 plastic pocket folders w/ fasteners
- ❑ 2 reams of quality copy paper (usually come wrapped in plastic)
- ❑ Clorox® or Lysol® Disinfecting wipes
- ❑ Box of Kleenex®
- ❑ Pack of Ziploc® bags
- ❑ 3-pack of tennis balls
- ❑ Headphones (in a case or plastic bag labeled with child's name)
- ❑ Craft supplies: paint, lunch bags, tissue paper clay, feathers, paper plates, glitter glue construction paper, double sided tape, sequins etc.
