



# 4<sup>TH</sup> GRADE SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

Students must be prepared to learn each day. Having their supplies ready every day is extremely important so valuable class time is not wasted. All supplies should be labeled with child's name. Supplies need to be replenished throughout the year, as they are consumed, broken or lost. It is a good idea to have some extras stored at home.

- A zippered pencil pouch (*no boxes*)
- 12 sharpened pencils (*no mechanical pencils*)
- 1 box of classic Crayola® 24 crayons
- 1 pack of thin markers
- 1 pack of colored pencils (*max 12 count*)
- 1 pair of blunt tip scissors
- 4 large Elmer's® glue sticks
- 1 8 oz. bottle of Aleene's® TACKY GLUE®
- 1 pencil eraser or eraser tops
- 4 different colored highlighters
- 5 colored dry erase markers
- 3 pens
- 1 protractor
- 1 pack of graph paper
- 1 sharpener with cover
- 1 pack of ruled index cards (*any size*)
- 1 roll of scotch tape
- 1" Binder with 5 dividers
- 1 pack 7/8" Post-It® Notes
- 5 Regular Wide-Ruled Composition Books
- 2 packs of lined loose leaf paper
- 2 reams of quality copy paper (*usually come wrapped in plastic*)
- Clorox® or Lysol® Disinfecting wipes
- Box of family-sized Kleenex®
- 1 container of liquid soap
- Headphones (*in a case or plastic bag labeled with child's name*)
- 1 2GB Jump drive
